Only 9 players selected a beginning of shootout may participate in shootout and only those players may be on the field. **Coaches should prepare a list of nine kickers and in what order they will kick. The coaches and remaining players must be on the sideline.**
- Shots will be taken from 12 yards back at a point select by the referee.
